Child Protection Policy – Code of Behaviour

Ensure rehearsals and other activities involve more than one other person being present or at least in sight or hearing of others.

Respect a young person's right to personal privacy.

Provide access for young people and adults to feel comfortable enough to point out attitudes or behaviour they do not like and to provide a caring atmosphere.

Remember that someone else may misinterpret your actions no matter how well intentioned.

Do not have inappropriate physical or verbal contact with others.

Do not jump to conclusions about others without checking facts.

Do not exaggerate or trivialise child abuse issues.

Do not make suggestive remarks or gestures.

Do not get close to or have physical contact with a young person without clearly explaining what you are doing.
